## Day 1 – MARI MARI CULTURAL VILLAGE

The Mari Mari Cultural Village is situated amidst a remote forest setting in Kionsom, Inanam; 25 minutes away from the hustle and bustle of the city. Visit the various traditional homes of Sabah's ethnic communities — the Bajau, Lundayeh, Murut, Rungus and Dusun, built by descendants of the tribes that they represent. Your friendly excursion guide will also give thorough introductions about the houses, making it a highly educational experience.

#### Morning

- Arrive at Kota Kinabalu
- Pick-up from airport and transfer to Hyatt Regency Kinabalu Hotel

#### Afternoon

- Transfer to Mari Mari Cultural Village
- Dinner is included
- Return to hotel

# Day 2 - KINABALU PARK & PORING HOT SPRING TOUR

#### 0730hrs

Meet at the hotel lobby and proceed to Kinabalu Park, Malaysia's Natural Heritage site. Journey will take approximately 2 hours - passing by villages, paddy fields along mountainous roads that wind along the Crocker range. A brief stopover at Nabalu, where a collection of native fruit, vegetables, local produce and handicrafts stalls await you.

#### 1000hrs

Arrive at Kinabalu Park. Enjoy the cool and refreshing mountain air. On a clear day, you will have a majestic view of Mount Kinabalu, the highest mountain in South East Asia.







#### 1330hrs

After lunch, visitors depart for the Poring Hot Spring located approximately 47km from Kinabalu Park. Poring Hot Spring is named after the tall bamboo plant that is abundant in the area. The area is renowned for its natural hot spring of sulfurous water that emits from the ground. There are Japanese Baths where visitors can soak themselves and let the invigorating sulfurous water stimulate the body. Visitors can also try the canopy walkway that provides visitors a walk along suspended bridges that form a canopy above the tropical Jungle.

#### 1530hrs

- Return to the hotel
- Lunch is included

### <u> Day 3 – SAPI ISLAND</u>

SAPI is popularly known as Tunku Abdul Rahman Park's island and it is the smallest island, but well-known for snorkeling. Spend half a day here at your own leisure. Experience sea-walking, an undersea adventure without the use of any diving gear, but only an air-hosed helmet.

#### 0900hrs

- Pickup from the hotel lobby and transfer to jetty
- Board boat for about 10-15 minutes to SAPI island
- Lunch is included

#### 1400hrs

- Return to jetty and transfer to hotel
- · Pickup from hotel and transfer to airport
