- a) On the browser menu bar, go to "Tools"
- b) Select "Internet Options"
- c) Select "Advanced" and scroll down to "Security"
- d) Uncheck the options "Use SSL 2.0" and "Use SSL 3.0"
- e) Check the options "Use TLS 1.0" (if available), 'Use TLS 1.1' (if available), 'Use TLS 1.2' (if available)
