


1. You will be prompted below error message when you tried to login to Velocity@ocbc after you have upgraded to Java 7 Update 71




# Uninstall Java Prior Version


2. Log in to an administrator account. Go to **Start > Control Panel**




3. Click on **Programs and Features**




4. Click on the prior Java version and click **Uninstall**


64-bit Windows operating systems (which may be Windows 7, Vista or XP) comes with a 32-bit Internet Explorer (IE) browser as the standard (default) for viewing web pages. These operating systems also include a 64-bit Internet Explorer browser, however using it is optional and it must be explicitly selected to view web pages. Note that because some web content may not work properly in a 64-bit

browser, we recommend using the default 32-bit browser and downloading 32-bit Java.

6. Wait for download to complete



7. Click on **Run** to proceed with the installation.



8. Please wait while the system is installing Java.




9. Click Restart my browser now to complete the installation, then Close to complete the installation.




1. Log in to an administrator account. Go to **Start > Control Panel**




2. Click on **Java**




3. Click on **Security tab**. Click on the **Edit Site List** button.




4. Click the **Add** in the Exception Site List window




5. Click in the empty field under Location field to enter the URL:

  - b. Click **Apply** followed by the **Ok** Button.






6. Click ok and go to **Advanced** tab.



7. Go to mixed mode section and select the option highlighted below,




8. Click ok and close all windows.


9. Restart the browser and try again.




# Login using Firefox

1. Launch Firefox and go to [bbmy.ocbc.com](http://bbmy.ocbc.com) > Click on **Login to Velocity@ocbc**




2. Some Firefox user may encounter the following message.



- Enter your **User Name**, **Password** and **Organisation ID**




5. Enter the Security Code displayed on your token and click on **Submit**.
