Urgency to Move-In

Undertake a handover or post-purchase inspection of a new property once the development is done to ensure your new home is completed to the agreed upon standards



Pre & Post Purchase Inspections

A pre-purchase inspection of water leakages, cracks, faulty wirings and other defects is critical to assess the extent of issues and the cost needed to remedy them.

Governed by the Housing Development Act (HDA), developers will bear the cost of repairs for defects, typically spanning 24 months.
