Don't be lured into receiving unsolicited job offers via social media that require you to make payment to purchase items in advance with the promise of receiving high commission pay-out. It's a SCAM!

SPOT the SIGNS and PROTECT yourself.

LOOK OUT FOR THESE RED FLAGS

- Employers who require payment before you can start work Legitimate employers will not ask you to pay for a job. If you are being asked to make payments to third-party accounts, it's a scam!
- Easy jobs offering lucrative commissions that are too good to be true Do not accept dubious job offers that offer lucrative returns for minimal effort.
- Unsolicited messages advertising job offers from unverified sources on social media and messaging apps
 Fake websites, emails and social media accounts can look like the real thing. Always call the company's official number and check if such a job is on offer.
