



Be Wary of Investment Scams!

An investment scam is when someone tries to trick you into putting your money into a promising investment but it is a fake.

What to look out for?

- Individuals offering investment opportunities via social media.
- Risk-free “investments” with huge returns.
- Investments with “guaranteed profit”.
- Too good to be true deals with limited-time offers.

How to protect yourself?

- Only invest with licensed investment professionals.
- Perform as much due diligence as possible about the investment scheme and the person offering the investment.
- It is critical to buy only securities products that are registered with the Securities Commission [SC] and Bank Negara Malaysia [BNM] so that you can seek recourse if things go awry.

What to do if you’ve been scammed?

If you’ve fallen victim to a scam, immediately:

- Call **OCBC Customer Service at 03-83175000** and **press “8” for Kill Switch**, or
- Walk into the nearest **OCBC branch**.
