



Be Wary of Investment Scams!

An investment scam is when someone tries to trick you into putting your money into a promising investment but it is a fake.

What to look out for?

- Individuals offering investment opportunities via social media.
- Risk-free "investments" with huge returns.
- Investments with "guaranteed profit".
- Too good to be true deals with limited-time offers.

How to protect yourself?

- Only invest with licensed investment professionals.
- Perform as much due diligence as possible about the investment scheme and the person offering the investment.
- It is critical to buy only securities products that are registered with the Securities Commission (SC) and Bank Negara Malaysia (BNM) so that you can seek recourse if things go awry.

What to do if you've been scammed?

If you've fallen victim to a scam, immediately:

- Call OCBC Customer Service at 03-83175000 and press "8" for Kill Switch, or
- Walk into the nearest **OCBC branch**.
